Aims

At Foxhole Learning Academy we recognise how important it is for pupils to start the day with a nutritious breakfast. Evidence shows that providing a healthy school breakfast at the start of the school day can contribute to improved readiness to learn, increased concentration, and improved wellbeing and behaviour.

As a school, one of our core aims is to work in partnership with our families in a way that places our school art the heart of the community. By providing a high quality and affordable wraparound care, we are able to support families experiencing a range of difficulties and offer a childcare solution to support our working families.

In addition to our breakfast club, we also offer after school wraparound care on a Friday afternoon from 1pm until 3.15pm. **This will not be running from September 2023 as our school day will be extending.**

Our wraparound care aims to:

- Support our families by providing a high quality and affordable wraparound provision.
- Provide planned play and social activities within the school environment.
- Offer nutritious breakfasts in a safe and friendly environment.

Allocated Places

The school environment and the minimum child ratios meet the requirements of DfE guidelines. Spaces are limited to 18 for Breakfast club and 26 for Friday Afternoon Club, it is therefore important that parents book spaces to avoid disappointment.

We are an inclusive school and are committed to meeting the needs of all children within our school community. However, unless it is carefully planned for, our wraparound care is not able to provide one-to-one support for individual children. If your child has additional needs and would like to access the provision, please discuss this with Charlotte Jane our school SENDCo.

The Breakfast Club will run from 8.00am until 8.45am from Monday to Friday during term time and are run within the school grounds. The Breakfast Club and Friday Afternoon Club will be closed during school holidays and for 5 days each year to provide staff training and development (INSET days).

The school reserves the right to make changes to the days and times offered due to unforeseen circumstances such as acts of nature.



Booking



Places are to be booked via the MyEd app in advance and will be offered on a first come, first served basis. Places can be booked up until the day before the place is needed. If you are having any difficulties with the MyEd app or booking places, please speak to Mrs Marshall in the office who will be happy to help.

Charges

The charges from May 2023 per session are as follows:

Breakfast Club - \pounds 1.50 per child, per session. We do not charge for children who are eligible for free school meals. If your circumstances have changed and you feel you may be eligible to claim free school meals for your child, please let us know and we can support you with this.

Friday Afternoon Club – There is no charge for this club.

Payment must be paid in advance when booking.

Payment is required via MyEd when booking your session (our online payment system).

In line with school and trust policies, the school reserves the right to withdraw a child's place if accounts are not kept up to date.

If you no longer need a place

Please let us know with as much notice as possible so we can offer the place to another child.
